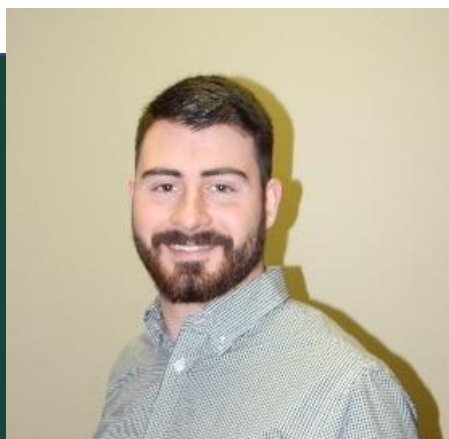




Matthew Ronald Maher Memorial Scholarship Application

Matthew Ronald Maher was an intern with the Center for Anti-Counterfeiting and Product Protection and a 2017 MSU graduate. Matt was a natural leader, characterized by his positive demeanor and uplifting spirit. He exemplified what it means to be compassionate, hard-working, loyal, trustworthy, and generous. His untimely passing does not diminish the impact he has had on MSU, the A-CAPP Center, and his friends. This scholarship was established by Matt's friends and colleagues as a tribute to him, and to perpetuate his memory.

Scholarship Details

Application Deadline: August 19, 2019

The A-CAPP Center will accept scholarship applications:

- For one full semester (or multiple semesters) at the A-CAPP Center: (fall, spring, summer)
- Funding for scholarship is determined based on approved project on a case by case basis.
- To work on brand protection and anti-counterfeiting research, outreach or education, which could include:
 - Research on a brand protection and anti-counterfeiting project jointly with a supervisor.
 - Independent brand protection and anti-counterfeiting research guided by a supervisor.
 - Work on an outreach or education project on brand protection jointly with a supervisor.
- Attendance and/or presentation at a conference that furthers the student's professional or academic goals and is connected to brand protection and anti-counterfeiting (examples: INTERPOL's IP Crime Conferences, International Anti-Counterfeiting Committee's Annual Spring or Fall Conferences, International Trademark Association's Annual Meeting, American Society of Criminology's Annual Meetings, etc.

Eligibility

To be eligible, a student must:

- Be a current MSU student in any degree program (non-degree students are not eligible); includes undergrads, grads, and professional
- Complete the entire application form & attach a recent transcript by the deadline.

Requirements of Recipients

Scholarship recipients will be recognized in at the awards portion of the A-CAPP Summit in September, where scholarship donors and other stakeholders may be in attendance. Scholarship recipients will be asked to write up a report describing what they learned through the scholarship; present the impact of their scholarship the following year at the summit; and complete a post experience survey about the internship.
